MONTHLY MEMORY VERSE

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. (Psalm 46:1)

Solomon's Wisdom (1 Kings 3:3-15; 4:29-34)

Nov 2

Brite Idea: Every good gift is from God.

He Question: Why does God give blessings to His people?

God loves His people so much and wants good for us. Every good thing comes from His grace and love.

We Question: How can we respond to God's blessings?

We can be grateful for all God does. We can be humble, putting His desires and the needs of others before our own wants.

The Kingdom Divides (1 Kings 11-12)

Nov 9

Brite Idea: God never gives up on us.

He Question: How does God feel about sin?

God is perfect and holy. He hates sin because it separates people from Him.

We Question: Does God still love us when we sin?

God loves us no matter what. There are consequences when we sin, but we can always have hope. God wants us to turn to Him and seek His forgiveness, which is available because of Jesus.

Elisha is Surrounded (2 Kings 6:8-23)

Nov 16

Brite Idea: God is working, even when we don't see it.

He Question: Why can't we see God?

God is spirit. He is invisible, but He is real and always present. He is always working, and we can see the great things He does.

We Question: What do we do when it doesn't feel like God is working?

We can trust God and ask Him to help us have faith that He is working even though we can't see it.

Esther (Esther 2-8)

Nov 23

Brite Idea: God always has a plan.

He Question: How can God have a plan for everything?

God is sovereign and in control. He loves us and knows what is best for the world.

We Question: Does God have a purpose for everyone?

We can trust God and ask Him to help us have faith that He is working even though we can't see it.

Forever King (Micah 5:1-5)

Brite Idea: God Promised a Savior who would be King forever.

He Question: How can Jesus be King forever?

Jesus is eternal. He has always existed and always will. Nothing can ever change that He is king over everything for all time.

We Question: Why does it matter if Jesus is King forever?

Since Jesus will reign forever, we know He can save us from our sins forever. When we have trusted in Jesus as our Savior, we can live forever with Him.

Nov 16 ----- God is working, even when we don't see it. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Philippians 2:13 What does this verse teach us about God?	Research different parts of the eye, then make an illustration of what you've learned.	PSALM 46:1 Where is God in times of trouble?	Do a puzzle together, working in different sections. Then bring the pieces all together to complete it.	Visit your local animal shelter together. READ TOGETHER: Esther 2-8 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
Nov 23 ----- God always has a plan. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Psalm 33:11 What does this verse teach us about God?	Design and decorate a scepter with any supplies or items you have at home.	PSALM 46:1 How can you use this verse to encourage someone this week?	Help kids trace and map out a plan for their future. Discuss how God's plans are better than any plan we could think up or imagine.	Bake your family's favorite cookies together. READ TOGETHER: Micah 5:1-5 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
