KEY VERSE

SYNOPSIS:

This is one of the most personal of all of Paul's letters. He dwells largely upon his own ministry. He opens his heart to the church in Corinth. He discloses his motives, his spiritual passion and his tender love for the church. Many were questioning Paul's authority and being swayed by other teachers attempting to teach a different gospel. This letter is a passionate defense of his calling and the gospel of Jesus Christ.
