KEY THEMES Putting aside divisiveness for the advancement of the gospel.

1 CORINTHIANS 13:1

SYNOPSIS:

The church in Corinth was founded by Paul on his second missionary journey. It had become infected with the evils that surrounded it in a promiscuous city. Some of the more powerful members of the church were displaying arrogance and one-upmanship. Paul writes this letter to encourage them to lose these attitudes for the sake of the gospel, to build up the faith of those who were weak and to be able to witness effectively to unbelievers.
