KEY THEMES

How can a sinful man approach a holy God?

LEVITICUS 19:2

Speak to all the congregation of the people of Israel and say to them, 'You shall be holy, for I the LORD your God am holy.'"

KEY VERSE

SYNOPSIS:

God desires to dwell in the midst of His people. However, man's sin separates him from a holy God. So, God set a plan in place on Mount Sinai so that atonement could be made for sin.

Leviticus (a continuation of Exodus) gives instruction on how to deal with sin and impurity so that the holy Lord can dwell with His people.
