KEY THEMES

The church must contend for one true faith once for all delivered to the saints, and people of faith must persevere to the end resisting the false teachers and following the truth.

JUDE 3:

"Beloved, although I was very eager to write to you about our common salvation, I found it necessary to write appealing to you to contend for thee faith that was once for all delivered to the saints"

KEY VERSE

SYNOPSIS:

Jude warns against certain people who had infiltrated the church and were perverting the one true faith. These false teachers had gained influence, and Jude was openly attacking them and those who were allowing this to occur. He is horrified over the spectacle of apostasy, but closes the letter with one of the most moving benedictions in the New Testament.
