KEY VERSE

SYNOPSIS:

Zechariah was a contemporary of Haggai. They both were entrusted with the message to Jerusalem to rebuild their city (and ultimately the temple) despite opposition and discouragement. But Zechariah also gives indication of a coming Davidic ruler. This new ruler (Messiah) will not be like the existing rulers but will be righteous and humble, bringing salvation. He will not only redeem his flock but rescue his city.
