KEY VERSE

SYNOPSIS:

This is likely Paul's last recorded words. He was in prison and knew that his death was not far off. So, this is a very personal letter from Paul to his dear friend, Timothy. It is twinged with loneliness, but also a call to persevere. Paul exhorts Timothy to continue in faithfulness and points to his own life as an example for Timothy to follow.
