KEY VERSE

SYNOPSIS:

This message is for the people of Judah. After seeing the destruction and exile of her sister, Israel, Judah refuses to turn back as a nation to her covenant obligations toward God. The Lord, once again, lays choices before the people of Judah. This theme of “the day of the Lord” is consistent throughout Zephaniah’s message. This approaching day shows two faces: one of judgment against those who sin against God, and one of blessing for those who follow him. God will show himself just in both punishment and praise.
