KEY THEMES

The Plan of Salvation: In the cross of Christ, God judges sin and yet at the same time manifests his saving mercy.

ROMANS 1:16

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek."

KEY VERSE

SYNOPSIS:

As the gospel spread through the early church, there became some confusion about how the Jewish customs and the law meshed with non-Jewish Christians coming to faith. Paul rights this letter to explain in detail how it all works together. Our sin separates us from God. We are all in need of a Savior. Jesus became the perfect sacrifice to cover our sins and make us right before God. We simply need to trust in that work to be saved. Nothing else can save us. Then, the Holy Spirit comes in to begin a process of making us more like Jesus. We all deserve death, but Jesus gives us life.
