Scripture: Titus 2:11-14

Also: John 8:1-11

Discussion Questions

1. What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
2. Read Titus 2:11
 - In the sermon, the rescue of grace was described. How would you describe this rescue:
 - In general terms - for all people?
 - In specific terms - for yourself?
 - Take a moment to celebrate (somehow, through prayer, song, testimony, a moment of silence, Scripture, etc) the rescue of grace!
 - What questions do you have (or have you heard) about God's grace-filled rescue?
3. Read the rest of the passage, Titus 2:12-14.
 - The passage indicates that grace teaches us, or trains us for four different things:
 - To renounce ungodliness and worldly passions
 - To live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age
 - To wait for our blessed hope (the appearing of God/Jesus' glory)
 - To be Zealous for good works
 - In the sermon these were referred to as "the requirements of Grace."
 - Have you ever thought of grace as having requirements?
 - What if you view those four things as a part of God's riches?
 - What questions does this concept leave you with?
 - What area might the Holy Spirit be prompting you to be taught/trained by grace?
 - What will it take for you to cooperate with Him in this?
